The Lynn COC is dynamic and responsive to both the unique needs of various sub-populations, the changing nature of these needs, and to the new community concerns. The Lynn COC strives to meet the immediate and long-term needs of every adult and child who is homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, to regain housing stability and improve the quality of life.

## **Scholarship Qualifications:**

- 1. All applicants must be Lynn Residents.
- 2. Applicants must be enrolled in a two or four year higher education program or an alternative career path.
- 3. Applicants must be a Lynn High School Senior
- 4. Applicants must meet the definition of Homelessness
  - An individual who lacks a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence
  - An individual who is sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship or similar reason, residing in a motel, hotel, trailer park, or campground, due to the lack of alternative accommodations, or living in emergency shelter, abandoned or awaiting foster care placement.
  - An individual who is living in a residence that is public or private and not ordinarily used for sleeping accommodations
  - An individual at risk of becoming homeless or who will imminently lose their housing
- 5. An applicant that met the homeless definition and overcame the hardship of homelessness

All applicants must complete the attached application and forward to Elaine White at Bridgewell, 10 Dearborn Road, Peabody, MA 01960, by **May 25, 2018**. Awards will be presented at the Annual Meeting of the Lynn Continuum of Care on **June 21**<sup>st</sup> at 8:00 AM.

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

In order to qualify for one of the scholarships, you must be a Lynn resident and enrolled in a two or four year degree program or an alternative career pathway.

Applicants will be considered based upon a combination of the following criteria:

- 1. Academics
- 2. Participation in extracurricular activities
- 3. Volunteerism, community work

## Eligibility Criteria – All Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- A high school student who is a Lynn resident
- Enrolled in a two or four year higher education program or an alternative career path
- Meet the definition of homelessness (individual who lacks a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence; sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship or similar reason, residing in a motel, hotel, trailer park, or campground, due to the lack of alternative accommodations, or living in emergency shelter, abandoned or awaiting foster care placement; living in a residence that is public or private and not ordinarily used for sleeping accommodations; at risk of becoming homeless or who will imminently lose their housing). OR
- Met the homeless definition and overcame the hardship of homelessness
