

CURWIN CIRCLE FAMILY PUBLIC HOUSING WAITING LIST OPENING

The Lynn Housing Authority & Neighborhood Development (LHAND) will be distributing applications for the **ONE, TWO, THREE and FIVE** bedroom units for the Curwin Circle Family Public Housing Program.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED APRIL 22, 2008 THROUGH MAY 2, 2008 AT THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE, 174 SOUTH COMMON STREET, LYNN, MA. APPLICATIONS WILL BE GIVEN OUT BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. – 4:00 P.M. MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, AND THURSDAY, AND 1:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M. TUESDAY, AND 8:00 A.M. TO 12:30 P.M. FRIDAY.

COMPLETED APPLICATIONS WILL ONLY BE CONSIDERED IF MAILED IN AND POSTMARKED PRIOR TO AND INCLUDING MAY 2, 2008. HAND-DELIVERED APPLICATIONS WILL ALSO BE CONSIDERED PRIOR TO AND INCLUDING MAY 2, 2008. APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THIS DATE WILL BE INELIGIBLE. FAXED AND E-MAILED APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Eligible applicants will be placed on an existing waiting list. Placement on the waiting list will be by lottery method and *NOT ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS*, as well as, by the appropriate preference/priority category.

These income limits are subject to HUD regulations. Applicants must also meet the occupancy standards established by the Lynn Housing Authority & Neighborhood Development and the Department of Housing & Urban Development.
